## Stall Application Terms and Conditions for the 2008 Racing Season at Northville Downs

Stalls assigned for the meeting conducted by Northville Racing Corporation (Hereinafter referred to as "NRC") at the racing facility known as Northville Downs, are assigned under the following terms and conditions, the acceptance of which is indicated by applicant's signature on the reverse side hereof.

1. NRC reserves the right to accept or reject this application in whole or in part and without written notice.
2. All owners, trainers, and caretakers are subject to the laws of the State of Michigan, and the rules and regulations of the Michigan Racing Commission, United States Trotting Association and NRC.
3. The applicant for stable space at Northville Downs agree to vacate the stalls and move the horses, equipment and personnel off the premises within twenty-four hours after notice to vacate has been received and within twenty-four hours after the conclusion of any harness race meeting at Northville Downs. NRC shall not be liable under any circumstances for any loss that may occur.
4. Horses allotted stalls may not race in any overnight event at other racetracks except with the approval of NRC Race Secretary. Violators will relinquish stall privileges.
5. All drivers must be approved by management and MHHA in order to compete at the NRC race meet and must have on file with track management a signed copy of this agreement.
6. NRC reserves the right to reject any entry, change to order of the program, place in eligible class if entered wrong, and to declare any event not filling satisfactory.
7. NRC reserves the right to require eight (8) interests in overnight events. In the event eight (8) interests do not enter, an event may be called off or another event substituted.
8. Entrance to the grounds may be denied to anyone not holding a valid Michigan Racing Commissioner's License.
9. Neither NRC or the owner of the racing premises will be liable for loss, injury, or damage sustained by the owners, drivers, or horses participating in any activities engaged in on premises. Owners, Trainers, and drivers or horses assume full responsibilities for their acts and the acts of their agents, servants, and employees in connection with all activities in which they engage on the premises and expressly agree to hold NRC harmless for any and all liability, claims, loss or damages in connection therewith.
10. Stalls will be granted only upon a completed and signed stall application. Stall granted must be occupied within seven (7) days of the beginning of the current year's NRC race meet. Stalls not occupied by said date shall automatically revert back to NRC, and the allotment will be considered void.
11. All horses must be tattooed and have a valid Health Certificate and a negative Coggins Test Certificate filed with the Race Secretary's Office before entries will be accepted.
12. The defacing or destruction of property leased or owned by NRC shall be grounds for expulsion. THE TRAINER WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL COSTS TO DAMAGED TACK ROOMS. There will be absolutely no transferring of tack rooms from one person to another.
13. Cars may be parked in posted horsemen's parking lot only. There is no parking permitted in the barn area.
14. Dogs must be tied or on a leash at all times. The management reserves the right to deny any Dog from the premises.
15. Absolutely no cooking or cooking appliances will be allowed in the tack rooms.
16. "Applicant on his or her own behalf and as an agent for any horse owner receiving stall space or upon entering for racing purposes, agrees that he and his principals shall be bound by all the terms and conditions of any written agreement between the track and the MHHA, including, but not limited to the distribution of purse money to said Association for Insurance, Welfare, Administration or any other contractual purposes, and further, the applicant or his principals agree to said contractual agreement although they may not be members of the Association and may not benefit directly or indirectly.
