

PRIZE STRUCTURE

- Total purse is \$2500 based on 50 entries. Prize awards will be adjusted according to the actual number of entries. All entry fees returned as prize money and tournament costs. Maximum 2 entries per person.
- If fewer or more than 50 entries, prize money will be paid to the top 3 finishers. Percentage payout will be 45% (1st), 25% (2nd), 17% (3rd).
- \$500 of the prize pool will be applied towards airfare and lodging for the tournament winner.
- Order of finish will be based on the highest accumulated pari-mutuel earnings.
- Winner earns a seat to the WHHC Final, April 29, 2017 at the Meadowlands Racing & Entertainment.
- In the event of a tie, prize money for those positions will be equally divided among entrants involved in the tie. In the event of a tie for 1st, the player with the highest win payout earns the WHHC berth. If, and only if, this situation, still results in a tie, than the tie-breaker will be determined by the first place entrant that picked the most winners in the contest.
- Prize pool money will be issued as a check within 7 days of the tournament once a completed W-9 is received. Players may cash out and collect their bankroll on the night of the tournament at its completion.

CONTEST FORMAT

- Contestants must bet a minimum of 5 Northville Downs Races
- \$10 minimum bet per race; no maximum bet.
- Win wagers only.
- One horse per race.
- Contestants keep all pari-mutuel winnings.
- Maximum 2 entries per person

CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

- \$100 is required with entry form. \$50 of which is for the entry fee and is non-refundable.
- Maximum 2 entries allowed per person
- Entrants keep all of their pari-mutuel winnings at the end of the contest.
- Entrants cannot add additional cash to their tournament bankroll. Doing so will result in automatic disqualification and elimination from the contest.
- Tournament races will be the entire program for Northville Downs on Friday April 7th. Entrants must wager on a minimum of 5 races. There will be 3 mandatory races. Betting less than 5 races will result in automatic disqualification.
- \$10 minimum bet per race, Win Wagers only
- One horse per race
- Contest wagering allowed on Northville Downs only
- Using your tournament voucher to wager on any race other than Northville Downs will result in disqualification.
- Withdrawing money before the last race is official or without approval from the Tournament Director will result in automatic disqualification from the contest.
- Players must place all wagers personally. No person shall directly or indirectly act as an agent in placing wagers for the Player. Tournament Director will be available if there is any questions as to how to place a wager.
- All tournament wagers must be made only at designated teller windows that are located in the contest area.
- In case of cancellation of a contest race or track due to inclement weather or other circumstances beyond our control, Northville Downs reserves the right to end the contest or designate alternative contest race(s) or track(s).
- No cancellations of any wager will be permitted. A late scratch will result in a refund and monies will be returned to the tournament voucher.
- All official Track Rulings apply to horses selected for tournament play.
- Northville Downs and Amtote Inc. are not responsible for “shut outs”, incomplete transactions or for mechanical failure of any tote machine used for contest wagering. No exceptions under any circumstances. All wagers should be placed early to avoid being shut out.
- The Third Floor Dining room will be home to the contest. All announcements and pertinent information regarding the contest will be posted in the contest area.
- All question or problems should be immediately reported to the Tournament Director.
- Northville Downs is not responsible for lost, misplaced, or stolen tournament vouchers.
- The decisions of the Tournament Director is final, they will handle all matters or disputes pertaining to this Handicapping Contest.

GENERAL RULES & ELIGIBILITY

- Must be 18 years of age or older with valid ID to register and participate in the Tournament.
- Winners are responsible for all applicable state and federal taxes and required IRS forms.
- All participants agree to have their name or image appear in any publicity material and be printed in any publication.
- Employees of Northville Downs, Amtote Inc, and MGCB are not eligible to participate.
- Licensed horse owners and trainers are eligible to participate, but are required to identify themselves in writing by completing and submitting the enclosed licensing form to tournament officials and identify any vested interest(s) they have in any tournament race(s) by completing and submitting the provided horsemen’s declaration form. All horse owners and trainers are ineligible to wager, for tournament purposes, on any race in which they have a horse(s) competing, and/or any other vested interest.

Northville Downs reserves the right to make changes to the contest or format as necessary.
